

Creative

The UK's creative industries contributed £104 billion to the economy in 2021, according to the Department of Digital, Culture, Media & Sport. This is a 43.6% increase since 2010 and means the sector makes up just under 6% of the economy as a whole.

In 2021, 2.29 million people were employed in the Creative Sector with 1.62 million in permanent employment with the remainder being temporary employees and this number is continually growing. These figures demonstrate that this has become a vibrant sector with lots of opportunities for individuals with all types of qualifications.

Its growth over recent years has been driven by a boom in computer services, highlighting the importance of digital creative industries such as video games.

Employment opportunities can be grouped into the following areas:

- Advertising and marketing
- Architecture
- Crafts
- Design
- Fashion
- Film, TV, video, radio and photography
- IT, software and computer services
- Publishing
- Museums, galleries and libraries
- Music, performing and visual arts

Working in the Creative Sector, you have the opportunity to pursue practical roles such as an artist, actor or interior designer, or administrative or managerial jobs such as an arts administrator or museum curator.

Within the Creative Sector there is an increasing overlap with both the Media and Information Technology Sectors. This can be seen in roles such as web designer, animator and game designer.

There is also a crossover between this sector and marketing, advertising and PR, with advertising in particular considered a key component of the creative industries.
