Educational administration includes any role that helps to keep a school, college or university running smoothly. Again there are a broad range of opportunities within the support side including:

- Admissions officer
- Reprographics Technician
- Careers Adviser
- Learning Support Assistants
- Librarian
- Finance administrator
- Administration

Although these are predominantly administrative roles you will feel very much a part of the education system.

As an Admissions Officer, for example, you will be reviewing and managing student applications, planning open days and interviews, and arranging

welcome materials for new students. Even in a less education-specific career, such as Finance Assistant, you will find different tasks and challenges in education than you would elsewhere.
