

Hair & Beauty

The Hair and Beauty Sector is an area that was hit by COVID-19 however with lockdown ending salons, spas and clinics reopened it is expected that many parts will and the industry has bounced back with us enjoying being able to go back to having our hair cut and styles or to have our nails done or treatments at a spa.

In 2021 the sector employed nearly 288,000 in 45,000 industries across the United Kingdom which generated an income of £6.6 billion to the UK economy.

The Hair and Beauty Sector provides many opportunities for young people to start their career within the industry as an apprentice. In 2020 there were over 7,000 apprentices employed in this sector.

As a Junior Stylist the average salary is £14,000 per annum rising to £30,000 for a Senior Stylist.

If you are interested in a possible career in the hair and beauty industry many salons provide opportunities for part-time weekend work where you learn the reception duties, customer meet and greet, hair washing and supporting the stylists.

In addition to being employed within a salon this sector gives many people the opportunity to be self employed and therefore able to work hours that suit their lifestyle. Currently approximately 60% of those who work in this industry are self employed.
